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## Verordnung

vom 27. April 2004

### betreffend die Abänderung der Verordnung über Wirtschaftsmassnahmen gegenüber der Republik Irak

Aufgrund von Art. 3 Abs. 1 des Gesetzes vom 8. Mai 1991 über Massnahmen im Wirtschaftsverkehr mit fremden Staaten, LGBL. 1991 Nr. 41, und in Ausführung der Resolution 1483 (2003) vom 22. Mai 2003 des Sicherheitsrates der Vereinten Nationen verordnet die Regierung:

#### Abänderung bisherigen Rechts

Die Verordnung vom 11. März 2003 über Wirtschaftsmassnahmen gegenüber der Republik Irak, LGBL. 2003 Nr. 91, in der Fassung der Verordnung vom 3. Juli 2003, LGBL. 2003 Nr. 152, wird wie folgt abgeändert:

56. **Sajida Khayrallah Tilfah**; Geburtsdatum: 1937; Geburtsort: Al-Awja, nahe Tikrit, Irak; Nationalität: Irak; wife of Saddam Hussein (listed above); Sajida Khayrallah Tilfah is Saddam Hussein's first wife and cousin who bore him five children (he currently has at least six children), including Qusay Saddam Hussein and Uday Saddam Hussein, both of whom occupied senior positions in the former Iraqi regime; she is Saddam Hussein's only officially recognized wife (Saddam Hussein currently has at least two wives)

57. **Raghad Saddam Hussein Al-Tikriti**; Geburtsdatum: 1967; Geburtsort: Irak; Nationalität: Irak; daughter of Sajida Khayrallah Tilfah and Saddam Hussein (listed above); Adresse: Amman, Jordanien
58. **Rana Saddam Hussein Al-Tikriti**; Geburtsdatum: 1969; Geburtsort: Irak; Nationalität: Irak; daughter of Sajida Khayrallah Tilfah and Saddam Hussein (listed above); Adresse: Amman, Jordanien
59. **Hala Saddam Hussein Al-Tikriti**; Geburtsdatum: 1972; Geburtsort: Irak; Nationalität: Irak; daughter of Sajida Khayrallah Tilfah and Saddam Hussein (listed above)
60. **Samira Shahbandar** (alias Chadian); Geburtsdatum: 1946; Geburtsort: Bagdad, Irak; Nationalität: Irak; wife of Saddam Hussein (listed above); Samira Shanbandar is Saddam Hussein's second wife and mother to his third son; her status as Saddam Hussein's wife only became widely known after Uday Saddam Hussein publicly murdered the man he held responsible for Saddam Hussein's introduction to Samira Shahbandar
61. **Ali Saddam Hussein Al-Tikriti** (alias Hassan); Geburtsdatum: 1980 oder 1983; Geburtsort: Irak; Nationalität: Irak; son of Samira Shahbandar and Saddam Hussein (listed above)
62. **Mohammad Barzan Ibrahim Hasan Al-Tikriti**; Geburtsdatum: 2. November 1972; Nationalität: Irak; child of Barzan Ibrahim Hasan Al-Tikriti (listed above); [Barzan Ibrahim Hasan Al-Tikriti, half-brother to Saddam Hussein, was a former presidential advisor and Iraqi Ambassador to the United Nations.]; Adresse: Genf, Schweiz
63. **Saja Barzan Ibrahim Hasan Al-Tikriti**; Geburtsdatum: 1.
