Verordnung

vom 23. Juni 2015

betreffend die Abänderung der Verordnung über Massnahmen gegenüber Personen und Organisationen mit Verbindungen zur Gruppierung "Al-Qaida"

Oktober 1999, 1333 (2000) vom 19. Dezember 2000, 1390 (2002) vom 16. Januar 2002, 1452 (2002) vom 20. Dezember 2002, 1735 (2006) vom 22. Dezember 2006, 1989 (2011) vom 17.
