# betreffend die Abänderung der Verordnung über Massnahmen gegenüber der Demokratischen Volksrepublik Korea

Aufgrund von Art. 2 und 14a des Gesetzes vom 10. Dezember 2008 über die Durchsetzung internationaler Sanktionen (ISG), LGBl. 2009 Nr. 41, in der Fassung des Gesetzes vom 9. Juni 2017, LGBl. 2017 Nr. 203, sowie unter Einbezug der aufgrund des Zollvertrages anwendbaren schweizerischen Rechtsvorschriften und des Beschlusses des Rates der Europäischen Union vom 28. Juli 2022 (GASP) 2022/1336 verordnet die Regierung:
